


Words of Chihiro Iwasaki

“If there is a child nearby, I would like to have him or her sit on my knee. I think parents cannot help but touch their children. I brought up my child emphasizing the importance of touch. Small children love to touch people. I love the strength of their grip, because such strength comes from such tiny hands. You cannot depict such movement simply by observing and sketching it. I love the feeling when children dash forward and jump up and hug you.” (1971)





“I experienced war early, as a force that dashes all youthful hopes. This had a major impact on how I lived my life.

I truly love peace, abundance, beauty, and adorable things. I feel limitless anger at the forces that would crush such things.

I think we are losing many things in today’s world. I believe the most important things in life, which are very simple but indispensable, are contained in picture books. My reason for living is to try to express these things and show them to the mothers of children.” (1972)

“Even without seeing a battlefield one can well understand how children feel in wartime and the effects it has on them. This is because children, from their innocent eyes to their lips and their hearts, are much the same all over the world. I think I understand this clearly because I illustrate children’s picture books.” (1973)

“When I feel weak and powerless (although I suppose that’s all the time), I am truly moved to tears by the warmth in people’s hearts. A person like myself, who is neither brave nor courageous, was probably born to draw pictures—not powerful oil paintings that stir people’s emotions, but modest Picture Book illustrations.

I hope that when the children who have seen these gentle picture books have grown up, they will still keep them somewhere in their hearts, so that when they face sad or desperate times they can be soothed by remembering even small bits of the gentle world depicted in these picture books.

I think this is my way of repaying a number of people and is my own reason for living.” (From Chihiro Iwasaki’s notebook, written in the last year of her life in 1973)

Exhibitions at the Chihiro Art Museums from 1977 to 1996

The Chihiro Art Museum was founded in response to popular demand, and since its opening has hosted numerous exhibitions of Chihiro's works on various subjects. The works of other artists have also been exhibited, including Picture Book illustrators such as Suekichi Akaba, Shinta Cho, and Květa Pacovská, as well as sculptor Churyo Sato and photographer Takeyoshi Tanuma. Over the past 30 years, the Tokyo facility has housed 232 exhibits, while the Azumino museum has shown 89 (as of July 2007).

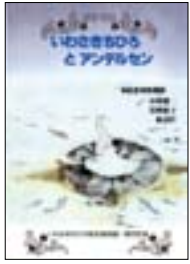
